Application under Working Holiday Scheme

Thank you for your application for a Working Holiday visa. We are processing your application and we will be able to tell you whether you are successful once you have met all of our immigration requirements.

Our assessment of your application

We have completed an initial assessment of your application and you are required to provide an [X-ray Certificate for Temporary Entry \(INZ 1096\)](#). We are therefore putting this matter to you, to enable you to provide this document.

We have not made a decision on your application at this stage and invite you to either submit this document within 15 days, or contact us as outlined below.

Why is this document required?

You are required to provide this document so that we can determine whether you meet our requirement to have an acceptable standard of health.

The relevant Immigration Instructions are A4.25.1 and WI2.1.1 which can be found at www.immigration.govt.nz/opsmanual. Please consult this information carefully as it sets out the relevant requirements.

For your convenience, you are able to print the [X-ray Certificate for Temporary Entry \(INZ 1096\)](#) form from the hyperlinks in this email. It must be completed by a registered medical practitioner. Please check the list of [Panel Doctors](#) to see if you need to use an approved radiologist to complete the form.

What you should do now

You are required to provide an [X-ray Certificate for Temporary Entry \(INZ 1096\)](#) within 15 days of your application being submitted.

Once the form has been completed, please write your application number XXXXXX on the top right hand corner, and submit it to one of [our nominated branches](#).

If you cannot provide the required document for any reason within 15 days, please contact workingholiday@dol.govt.nz as soon as possible. If you are able to show a genuine and reasonable attempt to provide this document to us, such as a confirmation of an appointment with your medical examiner, or a receipt for an appointment you have attended but have not yet received results from, we will take this into account.

NOTE: You may need a referral for a chest x-ray from a registered medical examiner.

All supporting documents must be original or certified copies of originals and, if not in English, must be translated into English by a recognised and independent translation service.

What happens if you do not send any comments or additional information?

If you do not submit an [X-ray Certificate for Temporary Entry \(INZ 1096\)](#) **within 15 days**, we will make a decision on your application based on the information you have already given us, unless we have granted you an extension. We are unlikely to approve your application otherwise.

False or misleading information

Providing false or misleading information or withholding information may make you ineligible for a visa.
